## NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH INFORMATION

On 2/16/2009 at 4:38pm a resident from Brandon Hall subdivision (located off of Windermere Pkwy.) called the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office to report a suspicious person/vehicle. The complainant advised the deputy that at approximately 4:00pm her daughter along with two other girls were playing at the end of their street when a man in a sedan approached the girls. The complainant stated that the girls told her that the man had what appeared to be a candy bar and motioned for the girls to come over to the car. The girls did exactly what they should have by running from the car and immediately informing a parent. When our deputies arrived the suspicious vehicle was no longer in the subdivision.

- The description of the vehicle is as follows: a bluish/green color 4 door sedan (possibly a Nissan Maxima type style). According to a witness the bumper was also missing from the car.
- The driver was described only as: a white male possibly in his 20's with dark curly hair.
